Biography

A Representative from New York. Born in St. Lawrence County, N. Y., April 26, 1944. Attended the public schools of Colton and Canton, N. Y. Graduated, Hugh C. Williams High School, Canton, N. Y., 1962. B. B. A., University of Notre Dame, Notre Dame, Ind., 1966. J. D., Albany Law School, Albany, N. Y., 1973. United States Marine Corps, captain, 1966-1970. Admitted to the New York bar in 1974. Lawyer, private practice. Elected, St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators, 1973-1975. Member of the New York state assembly, 1976-1980. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-seventh and to the five succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1981-January 3, 1993). Was not a candidate for renomination to the One Hundred Third Congress in 1992. Professor, Naval War College, Newport, R. I., 1993-1994. Private advocate. Business executive. Died on November 20, 2012, in Hedgesville, W. Va. Interment at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, Va.
