## **Biography**

A Representative from Washington. Born in Dillon, Beaverhead County, Mont., December 11, 1927. Moved with his parents to Monroe, Snohomish County, Wash., in 1944. Graduated from Monroe High School in 1946. Served in the United States Navy from January 1946 to November 1947. Graduated from Everett Junior College in 1950. Part owner-operator of gasoline station, 1950-1954. Graduated from Gonzaga University School of Law in 1958 and was admitted to the bar the same year. Deputy prosecuting attorney in Spokane and Snohomish Counties, 1958-1960, practiced law in Everett, Wash., 1960-1962. Prosecuting attorney, Snohomish County, 1962-1964. President of Snohomish County Young Democrats, 1960-1962. Board member of Snohomish County Democratic Central Committee, 1961-1963. Elected as a Democrat to the Eighty-ninth and to the six succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1965-January 3, 1979). Was not a candidate for reelection in 1978 to the Ninety-sixth Congress. Resumed the practice of law in Washington, D. C. Died on August 17, 2005, in Church Creek, Md. Interment at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, Va.
