A Representative from Kansas. Born in Quinter, Gove County, Kans. , December 17, 1976. Graduated from Quinter High School, Quinter, Kans. B. A. , Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kans. , 2000. Commercial real estate broker. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Twelfth Congress in 2010. Appointed Kansas state lieutenant governor, 2018-2019. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Kansas state lieutenant governor in 2019. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Seventeenth and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2021-present).
