Biography

A Representative from Pennsylvania. Born in Ellsworth, Washington County, Pa. , October 13, 1906. Attended the public schools of Washington County and East Bethlehem Township High School, Fredericktown, Pa. Was graduated from Waynesburg (Pa.) College in 1930, Detroit (Mich.) College of Medicine and Surgery in 1933, and Wayne University, Detroit, Mich. , in 1934. Began the practice of medicine and surgery at Fredericktown, Pa. , in 1935. Elected as a Democrat to the Seventy-ninth and to the fifteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1945-January 3, 1977). Chairman, Committee on Foreign Affairs (Eighty-sixth through Ninety-third Congresses), Committee on International Relations (Ninety-fourth Congress). Was not a candidate for reelection in 1976 to the Ninety-fifth Congress. Died on July 31, 1995, in Waynesburg, Pa. Interment at Beallsville Cemetery, Beallsville, Pa.
