A Representative from North Carolina. Born in Tiffin, Seneca County, Ohio, August 1, 1941. Graduated from Port Clinton High School, Port Clinton, Ohio, 1959. Attended Heidelberg College, Tiffin, Ohio, 1959-1960. At-large member, Charlotte, N. C. , city council, 1983-1985. Mayor, Charlotte, N. C. , 1987-1991. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the United States Senate in 1992. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourth and to the eight succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1995-January 3, 2013). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012.
