Member of the Michigan state senate, 1998-2002. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Eighth and to the four succeeding Congresses until his resignation on July 6, 2012 (January 3, 2003-July 6, 2012). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012.
