Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Twelfth and to the three succeeding Congresses until his resignation on February 16, 2017 (January 3, 2011-February 16, 2017). Director of Office of Management and Budget under President Donald J. Trump, 2017-2019. Acting White House Chief of Staff, 2019-2020. United States Special Envoy for Northern Ireland, 2020-2021.
