B. , Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge, Mass. , 1993. S. M. , Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Cambridge, Mass. , 1996. Business owner. Farmer. Judge executive, Lewis County, Ky. , 2010-2012. Elected simultaneously as a Republican to the One Hundred Twelfth and One Hundred Thirteenth Congresses, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Geoffrey C. (Geoff) Davis, and reelected to the six succeeding Congresses (November 6, 2012-present).
