A Senator and a Representative from Kansas. Born in El Dorado, Butler County, Kans. , August 9, 1960. Graduated from El Dorado High School, El Dorado, Kans. , 1978. A. S. , Butler Community College, El Dorado, Kans. , 1980. B. S. , Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kan. M. D. University of Kansas School of Medicine, Kansas City, Kans, 1987. United States Army Reserves, 1984-1991. Physician. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fifteenth and to the succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2017-January 3, 2021). Was not a candidate for reelection to the House of Representatives but was elected as a Republican to the United States Senate in 2020 for the term ending January 3, 2027.
