Adjunct professor. Assistant United States attorney for the Middle District of Florida, 2004-2006. Hillsborough County, Fla. , circuit court judge, 2007-2017. Attorney general of Florida, 2019-2025. Appointed as a Republican to the United States Senate to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Marco Rubio for the term ending January 3, 2029. Took the oath of office on January 21, 2025.
