S. , University of Wisconsin, River Falls, 1977. Attended University of Wisconsin, Madison, 1979, 1983, 1993. Mathematics teacher, football and basketball coach. Real estate developer. Builder. Owner, Neumann Developments, Incorporated, Janesville, 1986-1993. Unsuccessful candidate for the One Hundred Third Congress in a special election, May 4, 1993. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourth and One Hundred Fifth Congresses (January 3, 1995-January 3, 1999). Was not a candidate in 1998 for reelection to the U. S. House of Representatives but was an unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate.
