A Representative from Minnesota. Born in Fargo, Cass County, N. D. , June 29, 1944. B. A. , Moorhead State University, Moorhead, Minn. , 1966. United States Army National Guard, 1963-1969. Certified public accountant. Member of the Minnesota state senate, 1977-1986. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the Ninety-ninth Congress in 1984 and to the One Hundredth Congress in 1986. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred First Congress in 1988. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Second and to the fourteen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1991-January 3, 2021). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress in 2020. Chair, Committee on Agriculture (One Hundred Tenth, One Hundred Eleventh, and One Hundred Sixteenth Congresses).
