A Representative from Maine. Born in Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minn. , April 2, 1955. Graduated from Marshall-University High School, Minneapolis, Minn. , 1971. Attended University of Southern Maine, Portland, Maine, 1973. B. A. , College of the Atlantic, Bar Harbor, Maine, 1979. Farmer. Businesswoman. Member of the North Haven (Maine) board of assessors, 1981-1987, chairwoman, 1982-1983. Member of the North Haven (Maine) planning board, 1981-1991. Member of the Maine state senate, 1992-2000, majority leader, 1996-2000. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate in 2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eleventh and to the eight succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2009-present).
