A Representative from Ohio. Born in Beach City, Stark County, Ohio, December 3, 1924. B. A. , Mount Union College, Alliance, Ohio, 1948. LL. B. , William McKinley School of Law, Canton, Ohio, 1952. United States Navy, 1944-1946. Lawyer, private practice. Member of the Ohio state board of education, 1960-1964. Member of the Ohio state house of representatives, 1965-1966. Member of the Ohio state senate, 1967-1972. Delegate, Republican National Convention, 1972. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-third and to the seventeen succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1973-January 3, 2009). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eleventh Congress in 2008. Died on July 19, 2017, in Bethlehem Township, Ohio.
