A Representative from Maryland. Born in Baltimore, Md. , on January 31, 1946. Graduated from Baltimore City College, Baltimore, Md. , 1963. Attended University of Maryland, College Park, Md. J. D. , University of Baltimore School of Law, Baltimore, Md. , 1970. Lawyer, private practice. Assistant Maryland state's attorney, 1972-1980. Member of the Baltimore County, Md. , county council, 1985-1994. Delegate, Democrat National Convention, 1996 and 2000. Baltimore, Md. , county executive, 1994-2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eighth and to the ten succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2003-January 3, 2025). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Nineteenth Congress in 2024.
