A Representative from Ohio. Born in Monongahela, Washington County, Pa. , December 3, 1958. Graduated from Ringgold High School, Monongahela, Pa. , 1976. B. S. , Indiana University of Pennsylvania, Indiana, Pa. , 1980. Business owner. Member of the Wadsworth, Ohio, board of zoning appeals, 1994-1995. Wadsworth, Ohio, city council president, 1999-2003. Mayor of Wadsworth, Ohio, 2004-2008. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Twelfth and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2011-January 3, 2019). Was not a candidate for reelection to the House of Representatives in 2018, but was an unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Governor of Ohio in 2022.
