A Representative from Maryland. Born in Washington, D. C. , December 13, 1962. Graduated from Georgetown Day High School, Washington, D. C. , 1979. A. B. , Harvard College, Cambridge, Mass. , 1983. J. D. Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass. , 1987. Assistant attorney general, office of the Mass. State attorney general, 1987-1989. Professor, American University Washington College of Law, Washington, D. C. , 1990-2017. Member of the Maryland state senate, 2007-2016, majority whip, 2012-2016. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Fifteenth and to the four succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2017-present). Lead manager appointed by the House of Representatives in 2021 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Donald J. Trump, President of the United States.
