A Senator from Utah. Born in Detroit, Mich. , March 12, 1947. B. A. , English, Brigham Young University, 1971. J. D. , Harvard Law School, 1975. M. B. A. , Harvard Business School, 1975. Investment company founder and chief executive officer. Consulting firm chief executive officer. President and chief executive officer of the Salt Lake Organizing Committee for the Olympic Winter Games of 2002. Governor of Massachusetts 2003-2007. Was an unsuccessful candidate for the Republican presidential nomination in 2008. Was an unsuccessful Republican nominee for President of the United States in 2012. Elected as a Republican to the United States Senate in 2018, and served from January 3, 2019, to January 3, 2025. Was not a candidate for reelection to the Senate in 2024.
