A Representative from Arizona. Born in Salt Lake City, Davis County, Utah, January 21, 1958. Graduated Mesa High School, Mesa, Ariz. , 1976. B. A. , Arizona State University, Tempe, Ariz. , 1981. M. P. A. , Brigham Young University, Provo, Utah, 1986. Telecommunications executive. Community affairs manager. Member of the Arizona state senate, 1991-1995, assistant majority leader, 1993-1995. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Fourth and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1995-January 3, 2001). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Seventh Congress in 2000. Unsuccessful candidate for Governor of Arizona in 2002. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Thirteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2013-January 3, 2017). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Fifteenth Congress in 2016.
