A Representative from Ohio. Born in Akron, Summit County, Ohio, August 15, 1945. Graduated from Buchtel High School, Akron, Ohio, 1963. B. A. , University of Akron, Akron, Ohio, 1968. M. A. , University of Akron, Akron, Ohio, 1970. Teacher. Member of the Ohio state house of representatives, 1977-1983. Mayor of Akron, Ohio, 1984-1986. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundredth and to the seven succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1987-January 3, 2003). Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Eighth Congress in 2002. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Tenth Congress in 2006. Member of the Ohio state senate, 2007-2016. Died on May 20, 2023, in Akron, Ohio.
