London School of Economics, post-graduate studies in international law, 1970-1971. Deputy attorney general, California State attorney general's office, criminal division. Attorney, San Diego Gas and Electric Co. , 1972-1976. Special assistant to Vice Presidents Nelson A. Rockefeller and Walter F. Mondale, 1976-1977. Deputy secretary, California State Department of Business, Transportation and Housing, 1977-1980, secretary, 1980-1983. Attorney in private practice, 1983-1993. California co-chair for the presidential campaign of Michael S. Dukakis in 1988. Commissioner and vice chair, San Diego unified port district, 1990-1993. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Third Congress (January 3, 1993-January 3, 1995). Unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Fourth Congress.
