Biography

(Cousin of Francis Seiberling), a Representative from Ohio. Born in Akron, Summit County, Ohio, September 8, 1918. Attended the public schools of Akron, and Staunton Military Academy, Virginia. A. B. , Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass. , 1941. LL. B. , Columbia Law School, New York, N. Y. , 1949. United States Army, 1942-1946. Admitted to the New York bar in 1950. Lawyer, private practice. Associate with New York firm, 1949-1954. Volunteer service with New York Legal Aid Society, 1950. Corporate attorney, private industry, 1954-1970. Member, Tri-County Regional Planning Commission, Akron, Ohio, 1964-1970. Elected as a Democrat to the Ninety-second and to the seven succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1971-January 3, 1987). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundredth Congress in 1986. Faculty, University of Akron Law School, 1992-1996. Died on August 2, 2008, in Akron, Ohio.
