Analyst, Office of Management and Budget, 1981. Member of the Rio Hondo, Calif. , Community College board of trustees, 1985-1992. Member of the California state assembly, 1992-1994. Member of the California state senate, 1994-2001. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Seventh and to the four succeeding Congresses until her resignation on February 24, 2009 (January 3, 2001-February 24, 2009). Secretary of Labor in the Cabinet of President Barack Obama, 2009-2013. Member of the Los Angeles County, Calif. Board of supervisors, 2014-present.
