Member of the Georgia state house of representatives, 1974-1982. Member of the Georgia state senate, 1982-2002. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Eighth and to the eleven succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2003-present). Chair, Committee on Agriculture (One Hundred Seventeenth Congress).
