Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Ninth Congress, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Rob Portman and reelected to the three succeeding Congresses (August 2, 2005-January 3, 2013). Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Thirteenth Congress in 2012. Member, Ohio state house of representatives, 2021-present.
