A Senator from New Hampshire. Born in St. Charles, Mo. , January 28, 1947. B. A. , Shippensburg State College, Shippensburg, Penn. , 1969. M. S. S. , University of Mississippi, 1973. New Hampshire State senator, 1990-1996. Governor of New Hampshire, 1997-2003. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate in 2002. Elected as a Democrat to the United States Senate in 2008. Reelected in 2014, and again in 2020 for the term ending January 3, 2027. Chair, Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship (One Hundred Eighteenth Congress [September 27, 2023-January 3, 2025]).
