A Representative from California; born in Sac City, Sac County, Iowa, November 16, 1980; graduated from Dublin High School, Dublin, Calif., 1999; B.A. University of Maryland, College Park, Md., 2003; J.D., University of Maryland School of Law, Baltimore, Md., 2006; Alameda County, Calif., prosecutor; Alameda County, Calif., deputy district attorney, 2006-2012; member of the Dublin, Calif., city council, 2010-2012; elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Thirteenth and to the six succeeding Congresses until his resignation on April 14, 2026 (January 3, 2013-April 14, 2026); one of the managers appointed by the House of Representatives in 2021 to conduct the impeachment proceedings of Donald J. Trump, President of the United States.
