A Senator from Alaska. Born in Fairview Park, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, November 13, 1964. Graduated Culver Military Academy, Culver, Ind. , 1983. B. A. , Harvard University, 1987. M. F. S. And J. D. , Georgetown University, 1993. United States Marine Corps 1993-1997. United States Marine Corps Reserves 1997-present, attaining the rank of lieutenant colonel. Lawyer. White House aide and director on the National Security Council staff during the George W. Bush administration. Assistant U. S. Secretary of state for economic, energy and business affairs 2006-2009. Attorney general of Alaska 2009-2010. Commissioner of Alaska Department of Natural Resources 2010-2013. Elected as a Republican to the United States Senate in 2014. Re-elected in 2020 for the term ending January 3, 2027.
