Member of the Guam territorial senate, 2013-2018. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Sixteenth and to the succeeding Congress (January 3, 2019-January 3, 2023). Was not a candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress in 2022, but was an unsuccessful candidate for nomination for Governor of Guam. Unsuccessful candidate for nomination to the One Hundred Nineteenth Congress in 2024.
