Member of the New Mexico state house of representatives, 2019-2021. Elected as a Democrat to the One Hundred Seventeenth Congress, by special election, to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of United States Representative Debra Haaland of New Mexico, and reelected to the two succeeding Congresses (June 1, 2021-present).
