A Representative from California. Born in Hanford, Kings County, Calif. , April 14, 1977. Graduated from Hanford High School, Hanford, Calif. , 1995. Attended College of the Sequoias, Visalia, Calif. , 1996-1998. Farmer. Business owner. Member of the California state assembly, 2010-2012. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Thirteenth and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2013-January 3, 2019). Was an unsuccessful candidate for reelection to the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress in 2018. Elected as a Republican to the One Hundred Seventeenth and to the two succeeding Congresses (January 3, 2021-present).
