Biography

A Representative from New York. Born in Syracuse, N. Y., December 8, 1926. Attended St. Lucy's Academy, Syracuse. Graduated from Tully Central School, Tully, N. Y., 1944. B. S., Syracuse University, 1948. Attended Kings Point Academy, 1945-1946. Cadet midshipman, MMR-USNR, 1945-1946. President of publishing company. Publisher-editor, Eagle Bulletin. Director, Bank of New York (central region). Director, Wortley Drug Store, Inc. National Editorial Foundation, president, 1968-1973. New York Press Association, president, 1966. National Commission on Historical Publications and Records, 1977-1980. Director, Greater Syracuse Chamber of Commerce, 1979-1982. Elected as a Republican to the Ninety-seventh and to the three succeeding Congresses (January 3, 1981-January 3, 1989). Was not a candidate for renomination in 1988 to the One Hundred First Congress. Died in Fort Lauderdale, Fla., on January 21, 2014. Interred in Congressional Cemetery in Washington, D. C.
