### Biography

A Senator from Virginia. Born in Indianapolis, Ind. , December 15, 1954. B. A. , George Washington University, 1977. J. D. , Harvard Law School, 1980. Worked on the staff of Senator Christopher Dodd. Engaged in the high-technology business. Co-founded the company that became Nextel. Virginia Democratic Party chairman, 1993-1995. Unsuccessful candidate for election to the United States Senate in 1996. Governor of Virginia, 2002-2006. Chairman of the National Governors Association 2004-2005. Elected as a Democrat to the United States Senate in 2008. Reelected in 2014, and again in 2020 for the term ending January 3, 2027. Chair, Select Committee on Intelligence (One Hundred Seventeenth and One Hundred Eighteenth Congresses).
